Stop sell exchanges

Homes and businesses need to act fast for their alarm signalling to work after their phone lines have been migrated, which could be any time between now and the 2025 PSTN switch-off. Just be aware, the national stop sell – that means all exchanges – starts 5 September 2023.

You can also use Openreach's handy postcode checker to see which of your customers are affected by stop sell restrictions.

- 1. Head to Openreach's webpage "Our Ultrafast Full Fibre Broadband Build Plans".
- 2. Scroll down to the section entitled 'Is my exchange in your build plan?'
- **3.** On the map below, enter a postcode where it says 'Check your postcode'.
- 4. Click 'Go' and then 'Learn more'.
- **5.** If your customer is affected by a stop sell notification, you'll see 'We've stopped selling our older copper products...'

New stop sell list released

The move to all-IP is continuing to pick up pace with Openreach releasing its latest list of stop sells. From 5 September 2023, all exchanges will have a Wholesale Line Rental (WLR) stop sell implemented. That means there will no new supply of traditional phone lines, and any changes to an existing line will require an upgrade to all-IP.

Stop sell dates on the list after 5 September relate to fibre-to-the-premises (FTTP) priority exchanges. Where FTTP is available, it will be the only product you can buy.


